This community-run project rescues orphaned elephants and empowers over 1,200 Samburu women who provide goat's milk for the calves."

Bailey continues, Rwanda has so much to offer, from its rich history and culture to its breathtaking natural beauty. Akagera National Park is a prime example of successful conservation, having been revitalized over the past 14 years with the help of strong community engagement, it's now a thriving home for wildlife and provides exceptional encounters with nature. One of the most profound experiences in Rwanda is trekking to see chimpanzees and mountain gorillas. With only 1,063 mountain gorillas left in the wild, being in their presence feels like an extraordinary privilege."

Running Wild celebrates the enduring connection between Africa and Asia, two continents separated by vast distances yet united by their extraordinary biodiversity.
